The Loss Study states at page 2-5 that GSU losses were included as transmission losses if the meters were located on the low side of the GSU.

- i. Does PSCo charge purchasers of capacity and energy for GSU losses though its power sales contracts and tariffs?
- ii. If the answer to the foregoing question is in the affirmative, will inclusion of these losses in transmission loses result in a double recovery?

## **RESPONSE:**

- i. Yes. GSU losses are not specifically identified, but are included in the production revenue requirements.
- ii. No. The GSU losses were not included in the transmission losses since PSCo meters are located on the high side of the transformers.
