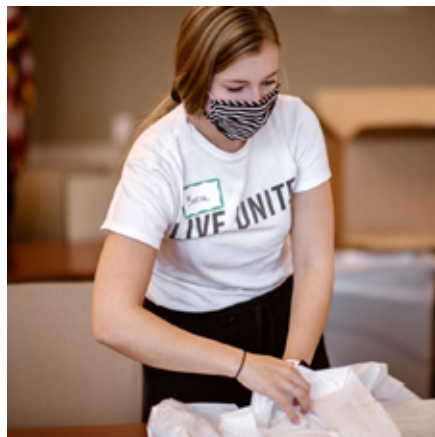

Throughout 2021, we put our good energy into action in communities throughout our Wisconsin and Michigan service territory. From volunteer projects to grants, our team curated opportunities and experiences for Xcel Energy to connect to our communities in meaningful ways. Looking Ahead

In March 2022, the Foundation revised its grant program to bolster our community impact, better align with the company's business priorities, and reflect our diversity, equity and inclusion commitments. The new program, Energizing the Future, strategically targets our foundation giving within three focus areas: STEM Career Pathways, Environmental Sustainability and Community Vitality.

United Way Giving Campaign

The annual United Way Giving Campaign is a strong tradition at Xcel Energy. The special campaign offers employees the opportunity to give to any 501c3 nonprofit and gifts are then matched dollar for dollar to their local United Way; retirees receive a \$.50 match to the dollar. Ten United Way chapters received funds from the campaign. Thanks to the generosity of employees, contractors, and retirees, Xcel Energy–Wisconsin and Michigan exceeded its fundraising goal by \$55,000.

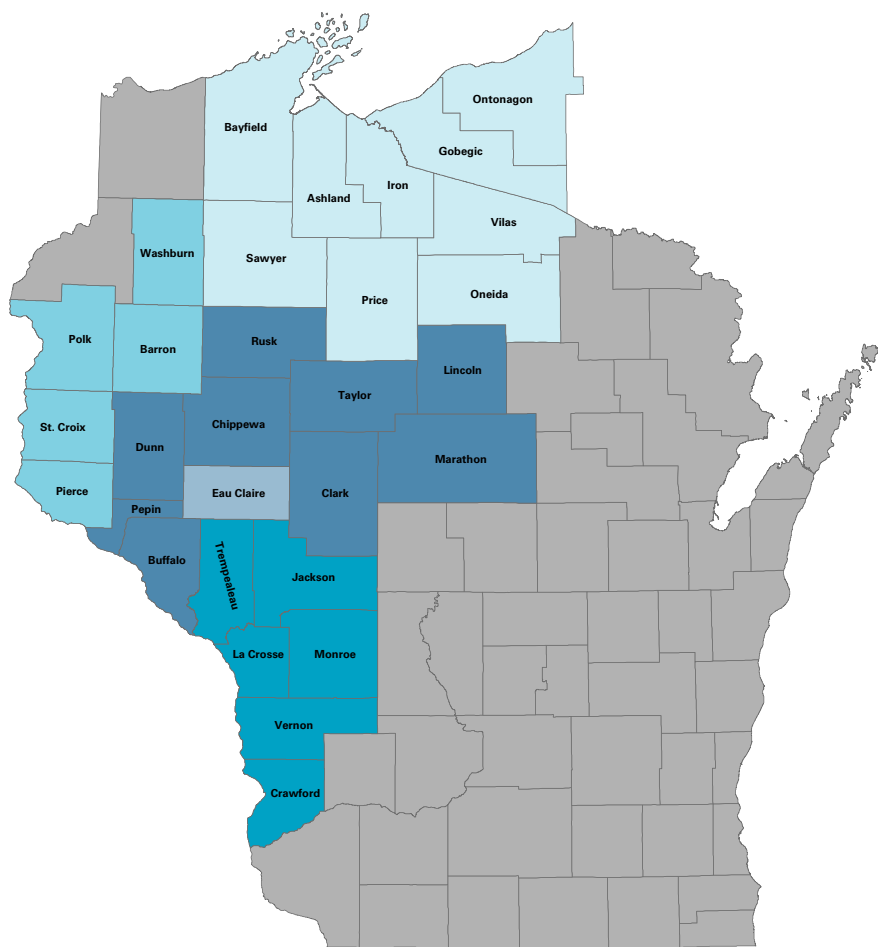
