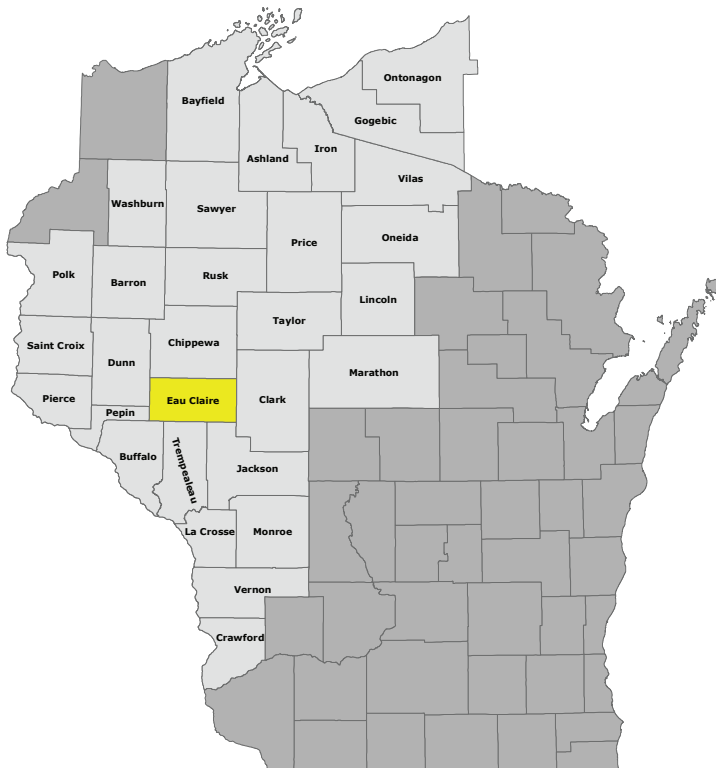
Here are examples of our team's involvement:
