> Summary of 60-Day Notice: School Education Kits

Public Service Company of Colorado ("the Company") posts this 60-Day Notice to make changes to the School Education Kits product in response to the 2018 Comprehensive Evaluation.

The evaluation provided key findings in the areas of product impact and Net to Gross Ratio, installation rates, program and kit enhancements, and cross-promoting other DSM programs. The Company will implement the following recommendations in 2019:

- Maintain a NTGR of 1.0
- Use an adjusted installation rate to account for a percentage of households that report they "will install" water measures but do not do so
- Work with the implementer to proactively target schools with a high percentage of students on free lunch programs
- Work with the implementer to evaluate new kit measures and in-school presentations
- Continue to improve the program's online resources
- Continue to include information on other program offerings in the kits
