The purpose of this filing is: to amend Advice No. 1728 - Electric filed November 15, 2016 to update the Fixed Solar*Rewards Community Service ("SRCS") Credit for each Rate Schedule and the Components of the C&I Customer Specific Credits to be effective January 1, 2017, pursuant to the Commission Decision No. C12-0606 mailed June 8, 2012 in Proceeding No. 11A-418E.

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Specifically, the Company files this Amended Advice No. 1728 - Electric to update the Solar*Rewards Community Service ("Schedule SRCS") tariff in compliance with Commission Decision No. C16-1075 approving the Non-Unanimous Comprehensive Settlement Agreement in Consolidated Proceeding Nos. 16AL-0048E, 16A-0055E, and 16A-0139E, to be effective January 1, 2017.

On August 15, 2016, the Company filed a Non-Unanimous Comprehensive Settlement Agreement ("Settlement") intended to resolve all issues in the Phase II Electric Rate Case as well as all issues in Proceeding Nos. 16A-0055E (Public Service's application for approval of its proposed Solar*Connect program) and 16A-0139E (Public Service's application for approval of its 2017-2019 Renewable Energy Standard Compliance Plan). The Settlement addresses several aspects of the Company's Solar*Rewards Community program for the development of Community Solar Gardens ("CSGs").

On November 15, 2016, the Company filed Advice No. 1728 - Electric and Sheet Nos. 114F and 114G for the purpose of updating the billing credits paid to subscribers of CSGs under Solar Rewards Community Service. Sheet No. 114F of Schedule SRCS set forth the "Fixed" credits for 2017, while Sheet No. 114G set forth the "Components for Calculating C&I Individual SRCS Credits for 2017".

In Decision No. C16-1078-I, the Commission denied the Company's Motion for Approval of an Alternative Form of Notice related to Advice No. 1728 - Electric. The Commission stated that the Company "may file an amended Advice No. 1728 - Electric" in the same proceeding (Proceeding No. 16AL-0882E) with a complete set of tariff sheets for Schedule SRCS. In this amended Advice No. 1728 - Electric, the Company will update the other terms of service for effect on January 1, 2017, in accordance with the Settlement provisions for the Phase II Electric Rate Case in Proceeding No. 16AL-0048E.

Notice of this filing will be placed in the legal classified section of <u>The Denver Post</u>, and will be provided by electronic mail to all intervenors in Proceeding No. 13A-0836E, the Company's last Renewable Energy Standard Plan, all customers who are subscribers to Solar Community Gardens, and all solar garden developers the Company has in the queue for solar garden contracts. The Company will also post this Amended Advice No. 1728 - Electric, Legal Notice and associated tariffs on the Xcel Energy web-site. A copy of the notice is attached as Exhibit 1. Contemporaneously filed with this Advice Letter, the Company is filing a Motion for an Alternative Form of Notice seeking authority to provide notice of the filing as set forth in this paragraph.

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It is desired that the tariff sheets accompanying this Advice Letter become effective January 1, 2017.
