## NOTICE OF REVISION TO THE ELECTRIC COMMODITY ADJUSTMENT ON LESS THAN STATUTORY NOTICE OF PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANY OF COLORADO 1800 LARIMER STREET, DENVER, COLORADO 80202-5533

You are hereby notified that Public Service Company of Colorado ("Public Service" or "Company") has filed with the Colorado Public Utilities Commission ("Commission"), in compliance with the Public Utilities Law, an application for permission to revise its Electric Commodity Adjustment ("ECA") on less than thirty days' notice. The revision will become effective January 1, 2021, if said application is granted by the Commission.

The purpose of the revision in the ECA is to reflect updated forecasted fuel, purchased energy costs, Cheyenne Ridge Revenue Requirements, Owned Wind Production Tax Credits (Cheyenne Ridge Wind Project and Rush Creek Wind Project), Rush Creek Capital Cost Sharing, Deferred Tax Assets Revenue Requirement, Renewable\*Connect subscription payments, Integrated Volt-Var Optimization Energy Saving Benefit, purchased wheeling expenses for the period January 1, 2021, through March 31, 2021, and the ECA deferred balance as of November 30, 2020, which was \$27,811,780 under-collected,.

The following table shows the current and proposed ECA rates for each of the Company's major customer classes. Secondary Voltage is applicable to all services at secondary voltage including: R, RD, RE-TOU, R-OO RD-TDR, RAL, C, NMTR, SG, SG-CPP, SGL, SST, STOU, SPVTOU, CAL, PLL, MSL, ESL, MI, SL, SSL, COL, SLU, and TSL. Primary Voltage is applicable to all services at primary voltage including: PG, PG-CPP, PST, PTOU, SCS-7 and SCS-8. Transmission Voltage is applicable to all services at transmission voltage including: TG, TG-CPP and TST. The Company will file a separate RE-TOU Compliance Advice Letter subsequent to this ECA Application to implement the RE-TOU and R-OO ECA of 51.63% as a result of Decision No. R20-0642 (mailed September 1, 2020) in the Company's RE-TOU Proceeding No. 19AL-0687E, to be effective January 1, 2021.

The Commission will consider all written comments and objections submitted prior to the evidentiary hearing on the proposed action. The filing of written comments or objections by itself will not allow you to participate as a party in any proceeding on the proposed action. If you wish to participate as a party in this matter, you must file written intervention documents in accordance with Rule 1401 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure or any applicable Commission order.

The Commission may hold a hearing to determine what rates, rules, and regulations will be authorized. If a hearing is held, the Commission may suspend the proposed rates, rules, or regulations. The rates, rules, and regulations ultimately authorized by the Commission may or may not be the same as those proposed, and may include rates that are higher or lower.

The Commission may hold a public hearing in addition to an evidentiary hearing on the proposed action and that if such a hearing is held, members of the public may attend and make statements even if they did not file comments, objections or an intervention. If the proposed action is uncontested or unopposed, the Commission may determine the matter without a hearing and without further notice.
