The purpose of this filing is to propose a newly created Advice Letter implementing the Solar\*Rewards Income-Qualified tariff that is borne from a bifurcation of the Solar\*Rewards Low-Income Community Solar Gardens from the Solar\*Rewards Community Service tariffs.

A SRCS-IQ Charge of \$0.05 per kWh has been added to cover the Company's costs of delivering electricity generated by a Company-owned SRCS Resources to eligible low-income subscribers (referred to as "SRCS Income-Qualified Subscribers"). This charge includes administrative costs to administer the subscriptions and is a Kilowatt-Hour charge based on each subscriber's allocation of the SRCS-IQ Resource that is calculated on a monthly basis.

Pursuant to the Motion for Alternative Form of Notice filed with the Commission contemporaneously herewith, in addition to posting the proposed tariff changes and Legal Notice
