You are hereby notified that Public Service Company of Colorado ("Public Service" or the "Company") has, in compliance with the Public Utilities Law, filed with the Colorado Public Utilities Commission ("Commission") an application for approval of its 2025-2029 Distribution System Plan ("DSP") and Grid Modernization Adjustment Clause ("GMAC") ("Application"). While the Company will file a subsequent advice letter on November 1, 2025 to ultimately implement GMAC rates, Colorado Senate Bill 24-218 ("SB 24-218") requires the Company to bring its proposed GMAC cost recovery framework forward for Commission approval with its DSP Application. The purpose of the GMAC is to provide for more current recovery of qualifying distribution costs, including those necessary to implement the Company's DSP.

Through the Application, Public Service has submitted a proposal to the Commission to expand, strengthen and modernize the electric grid to meet the evolving needs of our customers. Our DSP will allow us to continue providing safe, reliable service, energy products and programs to our customers – while shoring up the power grid to meet Colorado's clean energy goals. The DSP includes proposed investments and activities to increase distribution system capacity, enhance the reliability and resiliency of our system, and help the Company's electric distribution system to operate in a more efficient manner to support a broad array of State energy policy goals.

The Company proposes to update GMAC rates annually with the first GMAC advice letter to filed on November 1, 2025 with an effective date of January 1, 2026, subject to true-up and appropriate adjustments through future Phase I electric rate cases. Illustrative rates are provided below.

If you wish to participate as a party in this matter, you must file written intervention documents in accordance with Rule 1401 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure or any applicable Commission order.

The Commission may hold a public hearing in addition to an evidentiary hearing on the application. If such a hearing is held, members of the public may attend and make statements even if they did not file comments, objections or interventions. If the application is uncontested or unopposed, the Commission may determine the matter without a hearing and without further notice.
