

**NOTICE OF A CHANGE IN THE ELECTRIC RATES OF  
PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANY OF COLORADO  
1800 LARIMER STREET, DENVER, COLORADO 80202**

You are hereby notified that Public Service Company of Colorado has filed with the Colorado Public Utilities Commission an Advice Letter seeking approval to update the bill credit associated with the Company's Renewable\*Connect (R\*C) program in the Company's Colorado P.U.C. No. 8 - Electric tariff to become effective January 1, 2025. The Company's R\*C program is an optional service for customers to purchase photovoltaic energy by subscriber agreement.

Specifically, the R\*C Credit will decrease to \$0.03871/kWh in 2025 from the 2024 rate of \$0.04515/kWh. The decrease in the 2025 R\*C energy portion of the Credit (the amount of which is \$0.00644) is attributable to lower gas prices which reduce the avoided energy cost for the solar resource. This schedule does not directly affect any other service or customer classes. The annual impact on Company revenues is not known at this time as program costs for the year are not known. The Company reports the financial performance of the program annually in its Annual Renewable Energy Standard Compliance Report. Current and proposed total monthly impacts by length of subscription are in the following tables.

Written comments or objections shall be filed with the Commission, 1560 Broadway, Suite 250, Denver, Colorado, 80202, or email it to [www.dora.state.co.us/pacific/PUC/puccomments](http://www.dora.state.co.us/pacific/PUC/puccomments). The Commission will consider all written comments and objections submitted prior to the evidentiary hearing on the proposed action, if held. The filing of written comments or objections by itself will not allow you to participate as a party in any proceeding on the proposed action. If you wish to participate as a party in this matter, you must file written intervention documents in accordance with Rule 1401 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure or any applicable Commission order.

The Commission may hold a hearing to determine what rates, rules and regulations will be authorized. If a hearing is held, the Commission may suspend the proposed rates, rules or regulations. The rates, rules and regulations ultimately authorized by the Commission may or may not be the same as those proposed and may include rates that are higher or lower.

The Commission may hold a public hearing in addition to an evidentiary hearing on the proposed action and that if such a hearing is held, members of the public may attend and make statements even if they did not file comments, objections or an intervention. If the proposed action is uncontested or unopposed, the Commission may determine the matter without a hearing and without further notice. Notices of proposed hearings will be available on the Commission website under “News Releases” or through the Commission’s e-filing system.
