

**NOTICE OF REVISION TO THE CAPACITY AND ENERGY PAYMENT RATES  
APPLICABLE TO QUALIFYING FACILITIES WITH A DESIGN  
CAPACITY OF 100 KW OR LESS  
OF PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANY OF COLORADO  
1800 LARIMER STREET, DENVER, COLORADO 80202-5533**

You are hereby notified that Public Service Company of Colorado (“Company”) has filed with the Public Utilities Commission of the State of Colorado (“Commission”) Advice No. 1974 - Electric to revise the capacity and energy payment rates applicable to qualifying facilities (“QFs”) with a design capacity of 100 kilowatts (“kW”) or less in its Colorado P.U.C. No. 8 - Electric tariff (“Electric Tariff”) to become effective on January 1, 2025, if approved by the Commission. The principal proposed change is to revise the capacity and energy payment rates applicable to QFs with a design capacity of 100 kW or less, pursuant to Commission Decision Nos. C14-1153 and C16-0005 in Proceeding No. 13AL-0958E, and the terms and conditions of the Company’s Small Power Production and Cogeneration Facility Policy in its Electric Tariff.

There is an estimated decrease to the Company’s annual electric energy expense as a result of this rate change of approximately \$351. This is approximately a 9.19 percent decrease in payment to the affected QF. Any potential impact on the Company’s annual revenues that will result from this proposed rate change is negligible.

The following table compares the current and proposed Purchase Payment Rates applicable to Qualifying Facilities with a design capacity of 100kW or less.

The filing of written comments or objections by itself will not allow you to participate as a party in any proceeding on the proposed action. If you wish to participate as a party in this matter, you must file written intervention documents in accordance with Rule 1401 of the Commission’s Rules of Practice and Procedure or any applicable Commission order.

The rates, rules and regulations ultimately authorized by the Commission may or may not be the same as those proposed and may include rates that are higher or lower.

The Commission may hold a public hearing on the filing. If such a public hearing is held, members of the public may attend and make statements even if they did not file comments, objections or interventions.
