In accordance with the 2019/2020 DSM Plan Unopposed Comprehensive Settlement Agreement approved in Proceeding No. 18A-0606EG, the Multifamily Buildings program issued a Request for Proposal ("RFP") for 2019 and 2020 services. Pricing within the program is changing as a result of the RFP. The incentives for the Stage 1 Assessment and Stage 2 Direct Install measures will be adjusted under the new contract. These rebate changes do not affect customers directly as they will continue to receive the same services at no additional cost.

Additionally, the new technical assumption forecasts incorporate participation in the 1.25 gpm showerhead and 1.0 gpm kitchen aerator measures introduced earlier in 2019.
