Summary of 60-Day Notice: Peak Day Partners Pilot

The following 60-Day Notice summarizes the Company's action to clarify details regarding the recently launched Peak Day Partners ("PDP") Pilot.

The purpose of the Pilot is to provide the Company with an additional power purchase resource to more efficiently manage system requirements during periods of high demand, as well as provide customers with the option of receiving pricing associated with energy supply markets during such periods.

Pilot Update

The PDP Pilot write-up is being updated to allow for participation by customers taking service on transmission voltage which were inadvertently excluded in the initial 60-Day Notice. The Company has also received more preliminary interest in the Pilot and has updated the write-up to reflect the additional potential participation.

Due to the uncertainty concerning participation levels in the PDP Pilot, the Company will report on the specifics, including the number of participants, anticipated load reduction, and updated budget forecasts during its quarterly DSM Roundtables in 2020 to keep stakeholders informed.
