1		I. <u>WITNESS IDENTIFICATION</u>
2	Q.	Please state your name and business address.
3	A.	My name is Jeff R Lyng. My business address is 1800 Larimer Street, Denver,
4		Colorado 80202.
5	Q.	By whom are you employed and in what position?
6	A.	I am employed by Xcel Energy Services Inc. ("XES") as the Director of Energy
7		and Environmental Policy.
8	Q.	On whose behalf are you testifying in this proceeding?
9	A.	I am filing testimony on behalf of Southwestern Public Service Company, a New
10		Mexico corporation ("SPS").
11	Q.	Are you the same Jeff R. Lyng who filed direct testimony on behalf of SPS in
12		this docket?
13	A.	Yes.

II. ASSIGNMENT AND SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

Q. What is your assignment in this update testimony?

A.

As explained in SPS's direct testimony, SPS is using an Updated Test Year in this case. The Updated Test Year is the period from July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019. Because of the timing of the filing of this case, certain costs for the period from April 1, 2019 through June 30, 2019 ("Update Period") in my direct testimony were estimated. My assignment in this update testimony is to replace those estimated costs with actual costs. The result of this update is that the Updated Test Year now consists of only actual information, and no estimates. For ease of cross-referencing this update testimony with my direct testimony filed on August 8, 2019, the sections and subsections in this update testimony correspond with the original sections and subsections in my direct testimony.

Regarding the Policy & Regulatory Compliance affiliate costs I support, my direct testimony provided actual figures for April and May 2019 and estimated figures for June 2019 based on the forecasted budget. In this testimony, I replace the June 2019 estimates with actuals. In addition, the April through June 2019 expenses have now gone through the full pro forma adjustment review process. Thus, I provide updated figures for those Update Period expenses. My update testimony includes Attachments JRL-RR-UA through JRL-RR-UD in support of the Policy & Regulatory Compliance affiliate costs I support.

Q. Please summarize your update testimony and recommendations.

A. *Affiliate Costs* – The estimated Updated Test Year costs for the services of the Policy & Regulatory Compliance affiliate class that SPS sought to recover were

1	\$839,625 (total SPS before jurisdictional allocations, or "total company"). The
2	actual Updated Test Year costs for the services of the Policy & Regulatory
3	Compliance affiliate class that SPS seeks to recover are \$864,049. Please refer to
1	Attachments JRL-RR-UA through JRL-RR-UD. In addition to providing updated
5	SPS numbers, those attachments also reflect the total updated XES class expenses
5	for the Policy & Regulatory Compliance affiliate class. The actual costs are
7	reasonable and necessary for the reasons I provided in my direct testimony.

- 8 Q. Were Attachments JRL-RR-UA through JRL-RR-UD prepared by you or 9 under your direct supervision and control?
- A. Attachments JRL-RR-UA through JRL-RR-UD were prepared as described by

 SPS witness Melissa L. Schmidt. My staff and I have reviewed these attachments

 and I believe them to be accurate. Although the information I have described also

 is present in Ms. Schmidt's attachments, I have presented this information in the

 attachments to my update testimony for the convenience of those reviewing it.

- 3 A. Attachments JRL-RR-UA through JRL-RR-UD present the updated information
- 4 about the requested SPS affiliate expenses for the Policy & Regulatory
- 5 Compliance affiliate class. The detailed descriptions for Attachments JRL-RR-A
- 6 through JRL-RR-D that were provided in my direct testimony remain applicable
- 7 to these updated attachments.
- 8 Q. Are there updated exclusions for the Policy & Regulatory Compliance
- 9 **affiliate class?**
- 10 A. Yes. The actual exclusions are provided on Attachment JRL-RR-UC.
- 11 Q. Are there updated pro forma adjustments to SPS's per book expenses for the
- 12 Policy & Regulatory Compliance affiliate class?
- 13 A. Yes. As I mentioned in my direct testimony, pro forma adjustments are revisions
- to Updated Test Year expenses for known and measurable changes. Pro forma
- adjustments are shown on Attachment JRL-RR-UA, Column J, and on
- Attachment JRL-RR-UB, Column M. The details for the pro forma adjustments,
- including the witness or witnesses who sponsor each pro forma adjustment, are
- provided in Attachment JRL-RR-UD.
- 19 Q. Attachment JRL-RR-UD shows that you sponsor pro forma adjustments for
- 20 expenses for the Policy & Regulatory Compliance affiliate class during the
- 21 Updated Test Year that result in a net decrease for the Policy & Regulatory
- 22 Compliance affiliate class of \$1,692.57. Please explain the adjustments.
- A. The adjustments that I sponsor decrease SPS requested costs and are for costs not
- benefitting SPS, such as certain travel, alcohol, and employee life event
- 25 recognition expenses.

3	Q.	What is the purpose of this section of your update testimony?
4	A.	In this section of my direct testimony, several numbers were based on estimates
5		for the Update Period. In this update testimony, I replace those estimates with
6		actual numbers, and explain that the actual costs for the Policy & Regulatory
7		Compliance affiliate class are reasonable.
8		1. Additional Evidence
9	Q.	Is there additional support for a portion of the expenses that you present in
10		this testimony?
11	A.	Yes. Of the Updated Test Year costs for the Policy & Regulatory Compliance
12		class, 83.74% are compensation and benefits costs for XES personnel. SPS
13		witnesses Michael T. Knoll and Richard R. Schrubbe establish that the level of
14		Xcel Energy's compensation and benefits is reasonable and necessary.

16	Q.	Please state the dollar amounts of the actual charges (per book) from XES to
17		SPS for the Policy & Regulatory Compliance class of services for the three
18		fiscal years preceding the end of the Updated Test Year and the charges (per
