**NOTICE OF FILING OF PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANY OF COLORADO’S 2020
CLEAN AIR – CLEAN JOBS ACT (“CACJA”) ANNUAL FILING
AND REQUEST FOR ISSUANCE OF COMMISSION NOTICE**

Public Service Company of Colorado (“Public Service” or “Company”) hereby gives notice of the filing of its 2020 Clean Air – Clean Jobs Act (“CACJA”) Annual Filing in the above-referenced proceeding, in which the Company was authorized to implement the CACJA Rider beginning in calendar year 2020. In accordance with the Settlement Agreement approved by the Commission in Decision No. C15-0292 in Proceeding No. 14AL-0660E, the Company is required to submit an annual filing, on or around April 15, and provide detailed cost information on eligible CACJA projects from the previous year, explain material deviations between forecasted and actual costs, and provide sufficient documentation to demonstrate that no costs in the CACJA Rider were also recovered in the Company’s Base Rates. In addition, the Company is required to file robust direct testimony justifying expenditures as set out in Decision Nos. C12-0159¹ and C12-0163.²

This CACJA Rider True-up amount for the two months in 2020 is \$(155,558) and the Company will discuss options for refunding that amount in this filing given that refunding this immaterial amount over a year would be so small it is not possible to capture it in the Company's billing system, which only utilizes rates to five decimal places..

The 2020 Annual CACJA Filing being filed herewith covers the CACJA activities and costs undertaken during calendar year 2020 and satisfies the requirements of the Settlement Agreement and Commission order.

Pursuant to Decision No. C20-0096, in the Company's 2019 Electric Rate Case (Proceeding No. 19AL-0268E), the Company was allowed to roll-in the CACJA Rider costs³ into base rates effective February 25, 2020 thereby setting the CACJA Rider to zero with the exception of true-ups for prior years.

In this 2020 CACJA Annual Filing, Public Service demonstrates that the Company's implementation of the CACJA Projects eligible for inclusion in the 2020 CACJA Rider was prudent, that the actual variable non-fuel operations and maintenance ("O&M") expenses and capital expenditures for those CACJA projects was prudently incurred, and that the resultant 2020 actual CACJA revenue requirements are reasonable.

Public Service is providing public notice of the filing of the 2020 CACJA Annual Filing as detailed below, and further respectfully requests that the Commission provide

- Publishing a legal notice in the Legal Classified section of the *Denver Post* on Wednesday, April 21, 2021. A copy of the notice is attached to this Notice as Attachment 1.
- Posting to the Company's website the 2020 CACJA Annual Filing and the public versions of all related attachments.
