Midstream Lamp Eligibility Update

The Company will exclude three-way A-line lamps from the Business LED Instant Rebate offering in 2022. The product did not previously make a distinction between standard A-line lamps and three-way A-line lamps in the deemed savings; however, three-way A-line lamps are impacted by House Bill 19-1231 and are subject to the 3-year phase out prescribed in HB 19-1231 while standard A-line lamps are not impacted. The Company has chosen to eliminate three-way A-line lamp eligibility instead of applying a phase out to these bulbs for simplicity and to ensure product integrity and adherence to the law. This change does not impact the product forecast.
