**NOTICE OF FILING OF ANNUAL 2020 PIPELINE SYSTEM INTEGRITY
ADJUSTMENT ACTUALS REPORT AND REQUEST FOR ISSUANCE
OF COMMISSION NOTICE**

Public Service Company of Colorado (“Public Service” or the “Company”) hereby gives notice of the filing of its 2020 Pipeline System Integrity Adjustment (“PSIA”) Actuals Report (“2020 PSIA Actuals Report”) in the above-referenced proceeding, which corresponds with the Company’s previous advice letter filing in November 2019 implementing changes to its PSIA rider effective January 1, 2020. (Proceeding No. 19AL-0643G). In accordance with Decision Nos. R11-0743 and C11-0946 issued in Proceeding No. 10AL-963G, in which the Commission initially approved the Company’s PSIA tariff, and Decision No. C18-0983 issued in Proceeding No. 18A-0422G, in which the Commission approved a comprehensive Settlement Agreement extending the PSIA through 2021, the Company must file annually, on or about April 1, a report explaining the activities the Company undertook pursuant to its PSIA-eligible programs during the preceding calendar year, how the costs it incurred for these activities were managed, and deviations between previously forecasted and actual costs. The 2020 PSIA Actuals Report being filed contemporaneously with this Notice covers the PSIA activities and

costs undertaken during calendar year 2020.

The contents of the 2020 PSIA Actuals Report are intended to be in compliance with all of the requirements applicable to the Company's PSIA annual reports, as required by applicable Commission decisions, including those as adopted by Decision No. R14-0694 (mailed June 25, 2014) in Proceeding No. 13M-915G; Decision No. R14-0736 (mailed July 1, 2014) in Proceeding No. 10AL-963G,¹ as modified by Decision Nos. C16-0123 (mailed February 16, 2016) and R15-1204 (mailed November 16, 2015), respectively, in Proceeding No. 15AL-0135G; Decision No. R19-0696 (mailed August 20, 2019) in Proceeding No. 17AL-0771G; and Decision No. C18-0983 (mailed November 6, 2018), in Proceeding No. 18A-0422G.

Public Service is providing public notice of the filing of the 2020 PSIA Actuals Report, as detailed below, and further requests that the Commission provide additional notice of this filing through the E-Filing system to all persons registered to receive notices about natural gas matters. At Paragraph 57 of Decision No. R14-0694, the Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ") noted that the PSIA annual reports were informational filings for which "there is no statutory or rule requirement that Public Service give notice of the filing." At the direction of the ALJ during the February 10, 2014 hearing in Proceeding No. 13M-0915G, the parties to that proceeding conferred and, through Supplemental Joint Comments, proposed a process for Public Service to provide notice

for the PSIA annual report filings.² Specifically, Public Service would provide notice of the PSIA annual actuals report filings through the following three methods:

- Filing the PSIA annual report with the Commission;
- Causing a legal notice (in a form substantially the same as that attached to the Supplemental Joint Comments in Proceeding No. 13M-0915G) to be published in *The Denver Post* on the first Sunday in May following the filing of the PSIA annual report; and
- Posting to the Company's website the PSIA annual report and the public versions of all related exhibits.

The above proposed process for providing notice was expressly adopted by the ALJ in Decision No. R14-0694 and is being followed by Public Service for purposes of the accompanying 2020 PSIA Actuals Report. Provided as Attachment A hereto is a copy of the form of notice that Public Service will cause to be published in *The Denver Post* on Sunday, May 2, 2021.³

In addition to approving the above process for noticing the PSIA annual reports in Decision No. R14-0694, the ALJ further directed Public Service to request in a filing accompanying each of its PSIA annual reports that the Commission also issue notice of the report through the Commission's E-Filing System to all persons registered to receive notices about natural gas matters:

To provide notice targeted to persons who have a demonstrated interest in natural gas matters before the Commission and out of an abundance of caution, the ALJ will **modify the Supplemental Joint Comment to add an additional method of public notice: through the E-Filings System,**

the Commission will provide notice of the April 1 PSIA filing to all persons registered to receive notices about natural gas matters. The notice shall state that Public Service has made its April 1 PSIA filing, shall identify the proceeding in which the April 1 filing was made, and shall state that a request for hearing on the April 1 filing must be filed within 30 days of the date of the Commission notice. [Emphasis in original.]

To assure that this additional notice is given, the ALJ will order Public Service to make a filing that accompanies the April 1 filing and that requests: (a) that the Commission give notice, through the E-Filings System, of the April 1 filing to all persons registered to receive notices about natural gas matters; and (b) that the notice state that interested persons may file a request for hearing within 30 days of the date of the Commission notice.

In compliance with the foregoing directive, Public Service respectfully requests that the Commission provide notice of the Company's filing of its 2020 PSIA Actuals Report as outlined above.
