

➤ **Summary of 60-Day Notice:** Single-family Weatherization

The following 60-Day Notice summarizes the Company’s action to update the Technical Assumptions, Product Write-up, Budget, and Cost Benefit Analysis in the Single-family Weatherization product.

The Company is including with this Notice:

- Redlined Technical Assumptions worksheets;
- Updated cost-benefit analyses; and
- Redlined product write-up.

Through this notice the Company will remove the EC Motor Fan measure within Single-Family Weatherization for 2020. Forecasted participation and rebates for other measures were adjusted due to refocusing product resources following the removal of the EC Motor Fan measure. The impacts are presented in Table 1 below. This notice does not impact the Gas product.

**EC Motor Fan Elimination**

In the 2019-2020 DSM Plan, the Company inadvertently forecasted participation in the EC Motor Fan measure in the Electric forecast for 2020. Starting in 2020, EC Motors are considered standard efficiency by the Department of Energy and can no longer be rebated as an energy efficiency measure.
