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Description of Actions Taken To Control Fugitive Dust

Controlling fugitive dust at the Sherburne Country Generating Plan (Sherco) is addressed through a fugitive dust control program. Sherco is required to establish a Fugitive Dust Control Plan and follow it at all times.
