

Xcel Energy Bonus Rebates for Colorado flood-affected customers qualifying for FEMA assistance

As a valued member of our Trade Ally Network for Business Energy Efficiency Rebate Programs, we want to inform you we have received approval from the Colorado Public Utilities Commission to offer special bonus rebates to our customers affected by the historic flooding in September 2013.

Key points:

- Bonus rebates are in addition to regular rebates.
- Rebate amounts vary; **see below for details by business or residential program and by rebate program**
- Bonus rebates are retroactive to September 12, 2013
- Bonus rebates expire September 30, 2014, or when bonus flood-relief funds are exhausted
- To qualify for the flood-related bonus rebates, **customers must show proof that they qualify for FEMA assistance**
- There is no change or addition to the program rebate form. Use the program's 2013 rebate application. Bonus rebate amounts will be added to the standard rebate amount once FEMA assistance qualification is confirmed.
