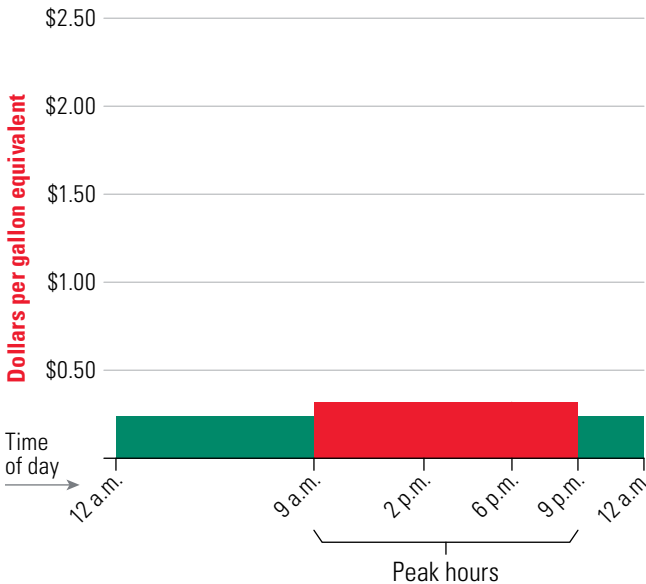


# Peak Demand Pricing

**Your bill includes demand charges and a charge for the amount of energy you use.**

Peak Demand Pricing customers pay the lowest per-kWh prices\* but also have demand-based charges. On-peak prices are 5 cents per kWh, and off-peak prices are 3 cents per kWh.



**\$2.80** Average cost of a gallon of gasoline in Colorado

This demand charge is based on the one hour of the month when your energy demand (kW) is at its highest, regardless of the time of day.

**Additional monthly Distribution Demand Charge:**  
**= \$3.57 x kW**

**Additional monthly Generation and Transmission Charge:**  
**= \$11.77 x kW (summer)**  
**= \$8.94 x kW (winter)**

This demand charge is based on the one hour of the month where your energy demand (kW) is at its highest between 2-6 p.m.

Note: Savings will vary depending on customer's ability to make changes to electrical use.

\*Many customers find this pricing plan to have the highest savings potential, but also the greatest risk if you accidentally use a lot of at once. In those cases, it will increase your demand charges for the entire month.

Prices are subject to resource and/or fuel adjustments, city fees and taxes where applicable. Prices may change upon approval. Peak hours and peak demand charges are not applicable on weekends and holidays.
