NOTICE OF INCREASE TO CREDIT/DEBIT CARD
TRANSACTION CONVENIENCE FEE
OF PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANY OF COLORADO

You are hereby notified that Public Service Company of Colorado has filed with the Public Utilities Commission of the State of Colorado, in compliance with the Public Utilities Law, revisions in its Schedule of Charges for Rendering Service in its Colorado P.U.C. No. 7 – Electric tariff to become effective August 21, 2013.

The purpose of the revisions to the Schedule of Charges for Rendering Service is to reflect an increase in the convenience fee that provides customers an option to pay their monthly electric bills using their credit or debit cards. Through August 18, 2013, the Company's credit card payment vendor charged \$4.85 per transaction. Beginning August 19, 2013, by changing vendors, the Company had anticipated that it could reduce this fee to \$3.45 per transaction. Due to technical difficulties, the new vendor will not be able to commence service for a few weeks. As a result, Public Service has filed to restore the \$4.85 per transaction charge during this interim period.

In accordance with Rule 1206 of the Rules of Practice and Procedure of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of Colorado, copies of the proposed and present credit/debit card convenience fees summarized above and as filed with the Commission, are available for examination and explanation at the main office of Public Service Company of Colorado, 1800 Larimer Street, Suite 1000, Denver, Colorado 80202-5533, or at the office of the Public Utilities Commission, 1560 Broadway, Suite 250, Denver, Colorado, 80202. Anyone who desires may file written comment or objection to this filing. If you only wish to object to the proposed action, you may file a written objection with the Commission. The filing of a written objection by itself will not allow you to participate as a party in any proceeding on the proposed action. Anyone who desires to file written comment or objection to the proposed action shall file them with the Colorado Public Utilities Commission, 1560 Broadway, Suite 250, Denver, Colorado, 80202 or email the document to: puc@dora.state.co.us at least ten days prior to the proposed effective date.

If you wish to participate as a party in this matter, you must file written intervention documents under applicable Commission rules.

Members of the public may attend any hearing and may make a statement under oath about the proposed revisions, whether or not he/she has filed a written objection or request to intervene.
