



Summary of 60-Day Notice: Motor & Drive Efficiency

Public Service Company of Colorado posts this 60-Day Notice to make the following change to its Motor & Drive Efficiency Product to be consistent with other products in the assumptions for the Deemed Savings Technical Assumptions submitted in August 2011 as part of Appendix E, Technical Reference Manual in the 2012/2013 DSM Plan, Docket No. 11A-631EG. To make the assumptions more accurate and consistent with Coefficient of Performance (COP) assumptions in other products, we are updating the COP from 2.3 to 2.28 for medium temperature applications and from 1.6 to 1.43 for low temperature applications. The updated coefficients are shown in the attached revision to the Deemed Savings Technical Assumptions file included in this Notice. We are proposing this change be effective for all rebates processed on or after January 1, 2013. These changes will not impact the goals or budgets, but are expected to result in a 1.9% increase in kWh savings for each electrically commutated motor project. This corresponds to an overall increase in forecast achievement of 0.2% for the Motor & Drive Efficiency Product.
